<p>Has epilepsy and liver shunt - first started treating for classic idiopathic epilepsy in Feb '18, and responded well to phenobarbital. But went into status epilepticus in May. Blood tests & scans confirmed presence of shunt which was successfully operated on in June. Vet wanted to reduce phenobarbital, however seizures recurred so as the shunt is closing well, epilepsy is highly likely although further blood tests to be carried out next week.</p>	<p>After shunt surgery, he is on KBr (325mg) twice a day. Levetiracetam (500mg) three times/day and Phenoletil (12.5mg) twice/day, raised from 6.25mg when seizures recurred. At initial diagnosis seizures were controlled with Phenoleptil 25mg twice/day but this dose is not good for recovering liver.</p>	<p>No indication of food relating to seizures but is now on hepatic diet due to shunt.</p>

No	Amazing regularity of seizures before medication, he would have one every 2/3 days then in another 15 days, then in another 2 and so on. Seizures were then controlled by medication, until status epilepticus occurred, probably due to hepatic encephalopathy. Has since had some cluster fits (3 per day) while changing dosage of phenobarbital	Ongoing, as still in recovery from hepatic shunt surgery and will not be able to isolate effects of this from idiopathic epilepsy until fully healed! I wonder if there is any correlation between the two conditions, as hard to imagine that brain toxicity would not affect an underlying tendency to epilepsy, even before it brought on encephalopathy.
